

NOTICE REGARDING LICENSED PUBLICATION MATERIAL

SQUARE ENIX CO., LTD. HAS THE PROPRIETARY RIGHTS TO THE PUBLICATION MATERIALS ("LICENSED MATERIALS") CONTAINED IN THIS MEDIA CD. BY OPENING, ACCESSING, AND/OR USING THE FILES CONTAINED IN THIS CD, THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH BELOW ARE DEEMED ACCEPTED BY THE PARTY OPENING OR ACCESSING THE LICENSED MATERIALS ("LICENSEE"). Square Enix Inc., or its affiliates (Collectively "Square Enix") hereby grants license to Licensee for the sole purpose to use Licensed Materials for publication intended for introduction of the game to the public in printed form ("Purpose").

1. License Restriction: Licensee shall (i) not utilize, copy, or distribute the Licensed Materials beyond the scope of the Purpose; (ii) not sublicense, rent or otherwise transfer; (iii) not reverse engineer, disassemble or decompile, attempt to discover or recreate the source code; (iv) shall restrict access to the Licensed Materials to those employees who have a need to know and who have agreed to comply with terms and conditions set forth in this agreement ("Authorized Employees"); (v) comply with all applicable laws, including U.S. export control laws, in the use of the Licensed Materials; (vi) not use the Licensed Materials not expressly granted to Licensee by Square Enix in any way; (vii) acknowledge that no title to or ownership of the Licensed Materials or any proprietary rights related to the Licensed Materials are transferred under the license.

2. Nondisclosure. Licensee shall not disclose to any person or entity except to Authorized Employees (i) any information about the Licensed Materials or Game or (ii) any other confidential information of Square Enix that becomes known to Licensee. Notwithstanding the foregoing, Licensee will not be liable for the disclosure of any confidential information which is (a) in the public domain other than by a breach of a duty to Square Enix, (b) received from a third party without any obligation of confidentiality; (c) known to Licensee without any limitation on use or disclosure prior to its receipt from Square Enix, (d) independently developed by employee of us; or (e) generally made available to third parties by Square Enix without restriction of disclosure.

3. Return of Licensed Material. Upon Square Enix's request, Licensee shall immediately return Licensed Materials to Square Enix, or destroy and/or remove all originals and copies of the Licensed Materials in possession in accordance with Square Enix's instructions.

4. Disclaimer. Licensee accepts the Licensed Materials "AS IS" and "WITH ALL FAULTS, DEFECTS AND ERRORS." **SQUARE ENIX SHALL HAVE NO LIABILITY FOR ANY ERROR OR DEFECT IN THE LICENSED MATERIAL, ANY INABILITY TO USE THE LICENSED MATERIAL OR ANY LOSS OF DATA. SQUARE ENIX MAKES NO WARRANTY, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, ARISING BY LAW OR OTHERWISE, REGARDING THE LICENSED MATERIAL OR ITS PERFORMANCE OR SUITABILITY FOR OUR INTENDED USE INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION ANY IMPLIED WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE.**

5. Limitation of Damages. Licensee acknowledges that **SQUARE ENIX SHALL HAVE NO LIABILITY (WHETHER ARISING IN CONTRACT, WARRANTY, TORT, NEGLIGENCE OR OTHERWISE) FOR ANY DAMAGES SUSTAINED BY US ARISING FROM USE OR INABILITY TO USE THE LICENSED MATERIALS, INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION ANY INDIRECT, INCIDENTAL, SPECIAL, OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES, EVEN IF SQUARE ENIX OR ITS AFFILIATE HAS BEEN ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SUCH DAMAGES.**

6. Termination and Remedies. In the event of any breach of any provision in this agreement by Licensee, the right to use this Licensed Materials by Licensee shall be revoked immediately, and the Licensed Materials shall be returned to Square Enix. Licensee agrees that any unauthorized disclosure or the threat of unauthorized disclosure of the Licensed Materials shall cause significant and irreparable harm to Square Enix, and inadequate remedies at law.
